- IV. Principal Rahne Report
 - December was a great month, every staff member got a gift card, very appreciative, also did 12 days of Christmas with different gifts each day
 - Holiday Lights was fun, we provided food donations to the Backpack Society
 - Adopt a Family – biggest yet in terms of number of families we were able to support
 - Marshall Fire victim support – discussed options for providing support for the community there, potentially through a local elementary school there. Amy Rahne will reach out to principals.
 - Covid update – school received air purifiers for all classrooms/library/cafeteria etc, following new CDC guidelines of reduction to 5 days of isolation rather than 10 (but mask required for the following 5 days), positive case in the household – students can still come to school but need to test after 5 days and then mask for 5 days. Separating classes in the cafeteria. Outbreak status is 5 cases per classroom.
 - Reading/writing/spelling program – Wonders (for all of Highlands Ranch region schools) will start next year
 - 386 students enrolled – several new students started today
