II. Financial Update

- Casa Caliente raised \$124, general teacher appreciation donations brought in \$230, Lucky Duck Bingo lost \$170, Breakfast w Books spent \$600 on food, PTO spent \$900 to buy lunch for the teachers, PTO spent \$1200 to stock teacher's lounge with food/drinks for teacher appreciation
- Book Fair: waiting for final numbers on how much will go back to the school/library but it was a big success, the goal was \$10k in sales and we exceeded it with \$11k in sales

III. Debrief of Recent PTO events

- Lucky Duck Bingo
 - i. Did virtual and in-person and it went smoothly, Amy Rahne and Kirsten Sola did a great job as emcees and managing the virtual component
 - ii. Spent more than budgeted this year due to having gift cards as prizes (which was easier due to having virtual plus in-person participation) rather than toys as prizes
- Book Fair
 - i. Huge success exceeded sales goal
 - ii. Teachers get \$400 per grade level to buy books for their classrooms
- Breakfast & Books
 - i. Turnout lower then anticipated but the event went well, the idea is for parents to have a donut with their kids and then visit the Book Fair and that was successful
 - ii. Leftovers from the breakfast will be used for 6th grade continuation in May, or donated to Backpack Society
- Teacher Appreciation
 - i. Stocked the teacher's lounge with snacks/drinks as well as some quick and easy to heat up food items, teachers are very appreciative

IV. Upcoming Events

- Scurry (CCE "fun run" type event): Kickoff will be 4/13, Actual event will be held 4/26
 - i. Fundraiser goal is \$30k, we use a company Boosterthon to help run the event
 - ii. Each student is asked to register on the website, goal is for 90% of students to register on the website
 - iii. Incentives (teacher dress up days, whole school pajama day if we hit the financial goal, etc)
 - iv. Local business sponsorships (checks made payable to CCE PTO, outreach letter was emailed out this week for community members to assist PTO in finding sponsors)

- v. For next year, we will explore local companies rather than Boosterthon to help organize the event, due to Boosterthon being expensive

 - i. Still looking for 1-2 more food trucks
 - ii. \$15 per person for wristband, give parents the option to "round up" to donate
 - iii. Idea: adult game area (putt putt, corn hole, charge \$ to participate)
