- II. Debrief of Recent PTO events
 - Open House (08/05) – PTO sponsored Kona Ice for our Open House
 - Popsicles on the Playground (08/10) – PTO provided popsicles
 - Kindie Tea (08/11) – intro to new kindie families, PTO provides coffee/pastries
 - New-dle Night (08/12) – welcoming new families to the school, it was well attended, PTO provided dinner from Mici
 - Carnival (08/20) – Fun Services and Big Sky Bounce, face painters, food trucks, 1st annual corn hole competition for adults with prizes
 - Back to School Night (08/24) – opportunity for parents to meet the teachers and learn about expectations for the school year, we'll do it earlier in the year next year
 - Restaurant Night – Chick-fil-A (08/29)
 - Scurry Fun Run (09/08)
 - This was our 1st year using Run4Funds, at our current tier of dollars raised CCE will keep 69% of the profit, if we surpass \$40K that will go up to 72% of profit
 - Parent feedback: would be nice if website gave notification for all donations given for your child by family members etc, easier Facebook posts

- III. Financial Update
 - Staff grants (\$100 per semester, must be used for expenses for students/classroom)
 - Total spent last year was \$9700
 - Carnival – loss of \$1000, typically a break-even event, weather was a factor
 - Staff lunch from Costco - \$200
 - 6th grade t-shirts for Outdoor Ed - \$1000
 - New-dle Night - \$650 for Mici dinner
 - Kona Ice for Open House \$1600
 - Income: earned \$1800 from King Soopers program and \$250 from Cold Stone
